REGISTRATION CHANGES & REFUNDS

- \$15 deposits are required per camper per week and are non-refundable.
- Change requests must be made by Friday at noon for the following week's session. Fees may apply.
- There will be no refunds after June 20. This includes your deposit and associated registration fee for the camp week(s) you selected. Charges will happen 8 days before the start of the camp session you registered for.
- In some situations, a refund may be issued if you are unable to attend a program because of a serious illness or injury, and written medical verification from your child's physician is provided.

Registration fees pay for direct operating costs such as staff, materials, and supplies. When you enroll, you are reserving the time, space, staffing, and provisions for your camper regardless of whether they attend.

CAMP HARBOR QUEST at Pioneer Village Grades K-6 | Dates 6/23-8/22

Our traditional day camp is nestled in the heart of Salem's Forest River Park. Campers take full advantage of the park and playground, pool and waterfront, and sports fields. Being an outdoor camp property we use commercial-grade canopies to provide shelter from weather, rain, and the hot summer sun. Our camp provides running water to keep campers hydrated. We believe it is important for families to know that our camp property uses porta potties to meet camper's bathroom needs.

Camp is filled with fun activities that will be driven by our weekly themes. Camper's enjoy a wide variety of sports and group games, arts and crafts, archery, low ropes adventure challenges, kayaking, swimming, and more.

• THE PRIVATEERS at Camp Harbor Quest Ages 5-6 | Dates 6/23 - 8/22

Our youngest campers are supported by our most energetic and experienced staff with a 1:5, staff to camper ratio. They participate in ALL of the activities with a modified schedule that limits distance traveled between activities.

• THE BUCCANEERS at Camp Harbor Quest Ages 7-13 | Dates 6/23 - 8/22

Our oldest campers will enjoy ALL of the activities as well as have a chance to participate in activities and challenges focused on team building for young leaders. Campers will be supported in a 1:10, staff to camper ratio throughout their day.

YOUNG TINKERS Ages 5-6 | Dates 6/30 - 8/22

Our Young Tinkers program is an exciting and hands-on summer experience for curious 5-6 year olds!
